Obligations

- Bond – Each Unit shall carry this to cover the Unit Treasurer, who handles the Unit's monies.
- Book of Reports – Each Unit shall purchase and keep on hand a copy of each year's Book of Reports.
- Comfort Articles – These are used by Hospital Representatives to use for patient needs, (toiletry items, etc.) during the year.
- Hostess Party – Parties are held for the hospitalized veterans each month. Some Units do not wish to schedule a party, so the Reps use funds donated to provide food for a monthly party. Some units wish to schedule a party for the hospitalized veterans themselves. They send whatever funds they wish to use for the party to the Department, in order to receive V.A.& R. credit. The check should be noted as "Unit Hostess Party Scheduled" and request that funds be sent back to them. The Department then returns the funds back to the Unit and the Unit receives monetary credit for the party.
- Rehabilitation Assessments - This is billed by National based on the senior members as of December 31 at \$0.15/member. It is split between both the VA&R and Children and Youth programs.
- Christmas Assessments – This money is used by our Hospital Representatives to provide a Christmas gift for each hospitalized veteran. It is \$0.30 per senior member of last year's final membership.
- Poppy – To support the VA&R program

Contributions:

- Children of Warriors National Presidents' Scholarship: Supports the children of our nation's heroes—our veterans. These scholarships are awarded to 15 students annually who excel in academics and volunteer in their communities.
- Auxiliary Emergency Fund: When a sudden financial crisis befalls an eligible Auxiliary member, the AEF may be able to provide temporary emergency assistance when no other source of help is available.
- Cavalcade of Memories – To preserve the memories of the Department of Georgia.
- Department Auxiliary Loan Payoff – Due to the bad economy, the Auxiliary has not met their financial needs and took out a loan to support operations while reorganizing operations.
- Department Headquarters Fund Raiser – This is to assist the Department in operations and whenever capital purchases are required for equipment.
- Department President's Special Project – The President has chosen to support Veteran's this year. The funds will be used in conjunction to support our VA hospitals.
- Past Presidents Parley – Nursing Scholarships given by the Department of Georgia Past Presidents. And two \$1000 scholarships from the Past Department Presidents.
