Department Finance

As discussed at the Department Convention, the Department of Georgia has encountered financial difficulty. For several years, the Department spent more than it took in; the economy had a major downturn; and membership dropped over 1000 members.

Last year a loan was taken out from the Department of Georgia, American Legion for \$40,000. The note is for 10 years with an interest rate of 3%. Terms we would not have gotten at any bank.

We have money in reserve. As a last resort we can use this to pay off our loan. However, if we are forced to do this we would not have a cushion in case of emergencies. So the Department is working very hard to keep costs down and raise money.

The IRS has said that all nonprofit organizations will be transparent in regards to finances. The budget is posted on the internet and can be viewed at any time by any member. Remember, it is your money and your Auxiliary.

This year's budget is not a balanced budget, but a true budget. The projected deficit is over \$12,000. The 2010 -2011 year ended \$25,737.98 in the hole. Funds toward different programs have been cut or decreased. Our Department office is operating on a bare bones budget. We are encouraging members to use their email to receive the newsletter and other correspondence. The Department pays \$10 per month for this email service, saving us over \$275 a month.

A review of the Poppy program was done last year. The labor to make the poppies was \$9950 and had never been included in the budget. The Auxiliary has been losing approximately 10 cents per poppy for the last several years. As a result, the price of the poppies was raised to \$0.15 per poppy this year.

With past budget shortfalls in mind and the decreasing membership, a \$1.00 increase for Department Senior

membership was proposed and passed at the Department Convention in Dalton. The increase will add approximately \$10,000 in income for the 2012 - 2013 budget year. Remember, this goes into effect starting the 2012 - 2013 year, please plan for this increase.

The cost for the Book of Reports is now \$15. Last year, the books cost more to print then we charged, so we lost money.

Units and members are being asked to help close the gap in this year's budget and also help pay down the loan. This is a bad time to raise dues, increase the cost of poppies and ask for more money. Your department is aware that times are tough. Please help as you can and be patient as the Auxiliary works to turn around our financial problems and become a stronger organization to help veterans and their families.

Coming next month: EIN, 990N and Unit Incorporation.
